Common Mistakes in EE300-EE400 Reports

- 1. Figures should have description.
- 2. Figure descriptions should be under the figure and centered.
- **3.** The meanings of the words "Figure" and "Visual" are same so choose one and use it throughout the entire report.
- **4.** Only "Figure" or "Visual" words and figure "numbers" should be written bold. Description part of the figure title should be written normal.
- **5.** All figures should be mentioned in text.
- **6.** Figures should be placed after where they are mentioned in text.
- 7. If you removed a figure from the report, check the figure numbers written in text.
- **8.** Unnecessary parts of a figure should be cut.
- **9.** You should write the references of the figures as you write other references. Do not write them separately and when numbering a figure reference continue from the previous reference number(Consider the report, including text, figures, charts, tables etc., as a whole)
- 10. You cannot write the figure numbers starting from 1 in each new part of the report.
- 11. You cannot write the reference numbers starting from 1 in each new part of the report.
- **12.** Reference numbers for figures should be written at the end of the description of the figure title.
- **13.** References numbers should be written in text. \rightarrow [1], [2], ...
- **14.** Writing the link of a website is not a proper way for reference.
- **15.** You should not copy and paste any text from a source and use it by simply writing a reference and using quotation marks. You must understand the text and rewrite it in your own words, and also write a reference.
- **16.** No need to write the same reference number to the consecutive sentences. Just write on the last one.
- **17.** References should be written in a proper style (Check the reference page of the report template)
- **18.** Tasks should be numbered as written in report template.
- 19. Main parts should be started in a new page.
- **20.** Use a simulation program instead of manually drawing the circuits.
- 21. Drawing something by hand on figures may not be considered as an engineering standard.
- 22. Do not change the titles of the main parts written in report template.
